

Bryan County Board of Commissioners - Called Meeting - January 17, 2003

A called meeting of the Bryan County Board of Commissioners was held on Friday, January 17, 2003. The following members were present: Chairman Brooks Warnell, Commissioner Toby Roberts, Commissioner Rick Gardner, Commissioner Ed Bacon, County Administrator David McCranie and County Clerk Donna Waters.

Chairman Warnell called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the bids on the gym expansion at the Richmond Hill Recreation Park.

Pratt Lockwood, Director of Public Services, gave an overview on the bids which were opened earlier in the week. Pope Construction Company was the low bidder with a bid of \$542,245.00.

A motion was made by Toby Roberts and seconded by Ed Bacon to award the bid of the ***gym expansion at the Richmond Hill Recreation Park to Pope Construction Company*** in the amount of \$542,245.00 with funds to come from SPLOST. Motion carried unanimously.

A discussion was held on the ***February 4, 2003 meeting***. Several of the commissioners are scheduled to go to Atlanta for the Legislative Conference on this date. A motion was made by Ed Bacon and seconded by Toby Roberts to change the February 4, 2003 meeting to February 11, 2003. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ed Bacon and seconded by Toby Roberts to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
