PRECINCT OFFICIAL GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA NOVEMBER 4, 2008

To vote, blacken the Oval ( ) next to the candidate of your choice. To vote for a person not on the ballot, manually WRITE IN his or her name in the space provided, then blacken the corresponding Oval ( ). If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval ( ). Use only pen or pencil. If you spoil your ballot, do not erase, but ask for a new ballot.

\* Understand that the offer or acceptance of money or any other object of value to vote for any particular candidate, list of candidates, issue, or list of issues included in this election constitutes an act of voter fraud and is a felony under Georgia law. (OCGA 21-2-285(f) and (21-2-363(e))
