CHAPTER 10

HIGHWAYS

ARTICLE I: GENERAL

10-101 Uniform rules of the road.

1. Adoption by reference. Except for an ordinance adopted March 16, 1976 setting speed limits on certain state routes and city streets, Title 40, Chapter 6 of the O.C.G.A., known as the Uniform Rules of the Road, are hereby adopted as and for the traffic regulations of this County, with like effect as if recited full herein.

2. Penalties. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, any person convicted of a violation of any provision of this code section shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment for not more than sixty (60) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

10-102 Right of way; general. Any applicant desiring to install utilities on, over or through any county maintained right of way in the county on or after the date of the passage of this ordinance shall first obtain a permit from the county commissioners by making an application for said permit through the county road superintendent on forms provided by the said superintendent.

10-103 Qualified applicant. Applications for permits under these rules will be accepted only from a political entity, an individual, partnership or corporation, or other body recognized by law as owning all or the major interest in the property abutting the highway right of way, or the proposed facility, which will be principally affected by the performance of the work covered by the permit or by the lessee of such. Such qualified persons will hereinafter be referred to as the applicant(s).

10-104 Filing. Application and permit forms will be filed with the Bryan County Board of Commission.

10-105 Permit. The provisions of any permit granted under this ordinance shall be construed as regulatory and not as contractual. No interest or right of an applicant shall be transferred to another except by written consent of the county commissioners. No inherent or retained right or privilege belonging to any abutting property owner is affected, interfered with or abridged because of these regulations or any permit issued thereunder, nor is the County of Bryan or the State Highway Department responsible

for any damage claim which may arise between the applicant and any property owner concerning said right of way or its occupancy or use.

10-106 Plans. All applications for permits shall have a plan with three (3) copies attached to them which shall identify and describe the type of work intended. The plan should show the centerline and the right of way line, indicating width; also the width of pavement, the location of existing driveways, drainage structures, elevations and/or sections thereof where necessary and the boundaries of the contemplated work. When grading is proposed, the drainage plan shall be shown. All applications shall give county and/or state route numbers, and distance from geographical points, such as intersecting highways, city or village corporate limits, or county highways.

10-107 Allocation of costs.

1. The entire cost of installing, maintaining, repairing, operating, or using the pole line, buried cable, pipe-line, or miscellaneous facility when performing miscellaneous operations and any other expense whatsoever incidental to the facilities or operations authorized by the permit shall be paid by the applicant.
2. The applicant shall, in addition to paragraph (1) above, reimburse Bryan County for any reasonable and necessary expense that the County may incur in connection with the facilities or operations authorized by the permit. The reimbursement to Bryan County shall be made by the applicant within thirty (30) days after receiving a statement from the Bryan County Commission.
3. The applicant shall, upon notification in writing by the County Commission, pay a reasonable market price for any materials removed from the right of way or destroyed as a result of operations authorized by the permit.

10-108 Applicant's duties.

1. The applicant shall employ any and all methods in performing the operations authorized by the permit which the chairman of the county commissioners or his designated agent may require in order to properly protect the public from injury and the highway from damage.

2. During the initial installation or construction of the facilities authorized by the permit, or during any future repair, removal, or relocation thereof, or during any miscellaneous operations, the applicant shall at all times maintain such flagmen, signs, lights, flares, barricades and other safety devices as the County Commission may reasonably deem necessary to properly protect traffic upon the highway, and to warn and safeguard the public from injury and/or property damage. The applicant shall maintain a watchman, as required, to maintain said signs, flares, barricades and other safety devices during non-work hours, and shall upon request furnish the county road superintendent the telephone number and/or address of such watchman.

3. The applicant shall so conduct his operations that there will be a minimum of interference with or interruption of traffic upon and along the highway. Except in emergencies, there shall be no interference with or interruption of traffic on and along the road or highway until a plan for the satisfactory handling of traffic has been worked out and approved by the County Commission or the county road superintendent as soon as practicable.

4. All roads should be bored where feasibly possible (dry bore).

5. All utilities crossing the right of way should be placed three (3) feet below the ditch bottom and those running parallel within the right of way or roadway either be placed two (2) feet inside right of way on the back slopes, or on paved roads three (3) feet from edge of pavement two and one-half (2 1/2) feet deep. Cuts not to exceed twelve (12) inches.

6. Any supervision and/or control exercised by the county road superintendent shall in no way relieve the applicant of any duty or responsibility to the general public, nor shall such supervision and/or control relieve the applicant from any liability for loss, damage or injury to persons or property.

7. The decision of the Bryan County Commissioners or its designated agent, shall be final and conclusive with respect to any of the conditions, terms, stipulations and provisions of the permit. This shall not foreclose the applicants' right of appeal.

10-109 Revocation of permit. Any permit granted by the county commission shall be revocable at the pleasure of said County Commission. In the event any facilities after construction become dangerous, unsafe or a nuisance to the traveling public using the highways, or in the event that such facilities should create any unreasonable interference with the proper use of the highways by the traveling public, or in case it

becomes necessary to use all the right of way to widen the existing roadway or to construct service roads or to make any other revisions in location, alignment or grade of the roadway,

making the approved entrance plan impractical, hazardous or otherwise objectionable, the permit for same may be revoked, provided, however, ten (10) days prior to such revocation the applicant shall be given written notice.

10-110 Relocation. In case Bryan County Commissioners should in the future decide to relocate and widen the existing road, Bryan County reserves the right to require the utility owner to take up or relay such sections of the facility which it may be necessary to take up and relay from an engineering standpoint; the taking up and relaying to be at the expense of the utility owner, without regard to the type of road construction or maintenance work involved.

10-111 Costs. The County Commission shall make no charge for permits for right of way encroachments.

10-112 Grassing. Any area where grass is destroyed, it shall be re-grassed. All applicants shall comply with county specifications:

1. all cuts across or into county paved roads shall first be tamped by a pneumatic tamp;
2. filled with eight inch (8") concrete;
3. finished with two inch (2") asphalt;
4. final inspection shall be approved by either the County Commission or designated agent (county road superintendent); and
5. applicant shall re-grass to State Highway Department specifications all county right of way areas which are damaged or disturbed during work authorized herein.

10-201 Authority. By virtue of the authority contained in the Georgia Code Section 40-6-200 and upon the basis of the report and recommendation of the State Traffic and Safety Engineer, Bryan County, Georgia, finds that stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles within the area of the State Highway System described in said report is dangerous to those using the highway and unduly interferes with the free movement thereon; and

1. It is ordered by Bryan County, Georgia, under the aforesaid authority, that the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles are prohibited within the limits of said area described as follows:

(1) Lanier Community, Bryan County, Georgia: That segment of roadway on the north side of the State Route 204 to be zoned for No Parking from 200 feet west of C.B. 49, M.P. 0.20, and 200 feet east of C.B. 49 M.P. 0.28.

(2) Signs to be erected by the Department of Transportation Maintenance Force.

(3) Be it resolved that any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished as provided for by law. This ordinance shall become effective when appropriate signs are erected.
