

Because of the current emergency declarations of the Governor of the State of Georgia, declarations by the Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court and the National Public Health Emergency declared by the President, and the immediate need to take measures to protect the safety of Bryan County citizens and to take actions pursuant to the Emergency Powers granted to the County under applicable provisions of Georgia law and ordinances of the County

The agenda will be as follows:

1. Call to order
2. Open Meeting compliance
3. Consideration of emergency declaration by Chairman and Commissioners in conjunction with the City of Pembroke and the City of Richmond Hill.
4. Adjourn

Notice. Attendees to the meeting shall comply with social distancing requirements set forth for COVID - 19 by the CDC.
