

Bryan County Board of Commissioners – Summary of September 8, 2020 Meeting

Members Present: Vice-Chairman Noah Covington, Commissioner Brad Brookshire, Commissioner Wade Price, Commissioner Gene Wallace, and Commissioner Steve Myers. Also present: County Administrator Ben Taylor, County Clerk Donna Waters and County Attorney Lea Holliday.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Gene Wallace and seconded by Steve Myers to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of August 2020 Meeting Minutes: Motion by Steve Myers and seconded by Wade Price to approve the meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Case Z#230-20 – Doug and Teresa Salmeron Rezoning: Motion by Wade Price and seconded by Brad Brookshire to approve the rezoning for Doug and Teresa Salmeron to AR-1 with the condition that the parcels be combined. Motion carried unanimously.

Medline Amended and Restated MOU: Motion by Steve Myers and seconded by Brad Brookshire to approve the resolution authorizing the execution of the amended and restated MOU for Medline Industries. Motion carried unanimously.

IGA for Bond Financing for Development Authority: Motion by Steve Myers and seconded by Wade Price to approve the intergovernmental contract for DABC bond financing. Motion carried unanimously.

Appointment to Development Authority of Bryan County: Motion by Steve Myers and seconded by Wade Price to approve Donald Montgomery to the Development Authority of Bryan County with a term to begin January 1, 2021 and expire on July 31, 2021, with staff finding a way to advertise future vacancies. Voting for: Myers, Brookshire and Price. Voting against: Wallace. Motion carried.

Appointment to Coastal Workforce Development Board: Motion by Brad Brookshire and seconded by Gene Wallace to appoint Rebecca Bohlander to the Coastal Workforce Development Board with a term to end June 30, 2023. Motion carried unanimously.

Paul Fulmore met with the board under public comments to talk about the condition of Letcher Road.
